#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

Anglo Stainless Limited is committed to operating ethically and wishes to ensure that its supply chains have a similar commitment. Anglo Stainless Limited recognises that the standards set by both the United Nations and the International Labour Organisation (ILO) defines the best practice in the conduct of suppliers. Compliance with these standards is a mandatory condition for suppliers contracting with Anglo Stainless Limited. Anglo Stainless Limited requires its suppliers to take all reasonable steps to ensure compliance within their own supply chains.
